The Journey of the Feminist Republik Festivals

The Feminist Republik Festivals promote and advance collective care and healing as integral to women's human rights and feminist organising. The Festival provides bold models and reimaginings of how WHRDs can convene in ways that centre healing as a cornerstone of our dreams for transformation and social justice.

The 1st Feminist Republik Festival (December 2019, Naivasha, Kenya) launched a bold political intervention, bringing together more than 300 African WHRDs in the face of structural violence, surveillance, and burnout.

The 2nd Feminist Republik Festival (November 2022, Naivasha, Kenya) gathered over 600 WHRDs, and funders to reclaim healing justice as a radical feminist practice in the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic.



The 3rd Feminist Republik Festival, themed "Regenerating in the Storm: Grounding Healing & Collective Care in Conflict Settings," reaffirms Urgent Action Fund Africa's commitment to the survival and well-being of women's human rights defenders, especially those living in conflict and crisis.

At the 3rd Feminist Republik Festival, funders will engage in a vibrant convergence of dialogue in a co-designed space. The Festival highlights the knowledge of WHRDs, focusing on 13 active conflict and crisis settings across the continent.

Participants will hear directly from African women human rights leaders working in conflict areas, unpack locally-led feminist and women's rights approaches to crisis, and explore funding practices and financing models grounded in justice, healing, and transformation.

Why We Gather: The Political Moment

Globally, we are experiencing multiple, complex, and protracted crises; particularly felt across the African continent. More than 24 million people are facing food insecurity. Over 12.1 million people are at risk of gender-based violence and sexual abuse. And the global philanthropic sector is simultaneously undergoing significant shifts.

This moment of profound transition requires adaptability, creativity, and swift responsiveness from philanthropic actors and ecosystem allies.

The Funding Partners' Gungano Invitation

Scheduled for 23-26 November 2025, in Kitui and Mombasa, Kenya, is the Funding Partners' Gungano, themed, *Weathering the Storm: Seeding the Future*. The Gungano is a thoughtfully curated, intergenerational, transnational assembly of mostly philanthropic actors committed to transforming how power and resources flow, particularly in humanitarian contexts.

The Gungano provides participants with a vital space to collectively reflect, learn, and build concrete agendas that respond to the turmoil that has disrupted and reorganised the philanthropic architecture. The Gungano journey begins on 23 November with an immersive visit to the Feminist Republik Healing Farm in Kitui, followed by travel to Mombasa on 24 November. The core Gungano meeting will be held from 25 to 26 November at the Serena Beach Resort. It will bring together a diverse ecosystem of actors, including bilateral entities, humanitarian funders, women and feminist funds, private and public philanthropy, academia, and select WHRDs.

This Gungano moves beyond reflection towards bold strategising: utilising insights from UAF-Africa's grant-making praxis and data, peer feminist and women's funds case studies. From women's human rights leaders and peer human rights and humanitarian funders, we will interrogate how philanthropies must evolve to remain relevant, responsive, and rooted in African women's rights and community realities.

On November 23, just before the Gungano, we invite you to an immersive visit to the Feminist Republik Healing Farm; a visionary space seeded by African Women Human Rights Defenders (WHRDs) in partnership with Urgent Action Fund-Africa. Established in 2019, the Healing Farm is a bold, feminist experiment in healing justice, collective care, and alternative financing for movements.

Rooted in indigenous and African feminist traditions, the Farm offers a sanctuary for WHRDs to rest, reconnect with nature, and ideate solutions together. It is also a social enterprise and sustainability model that supports retreats, convenings, and community health services. During our visit, we will explore how the Healing Farm nurtures resilience, sustains activism, and reimagines how feminist movements can be resourced with care, creativity, and dignity.

Convening report

TrustAfrica, Wallace Global Fund and Omidyar Network hosted the inaugural African Social Movements Baraza with the aim to bridge the digital and physical divides between social movements, and facilitate intermovement experience sharing and co-learning. Hosted in Harare, Zimbabwe on the 15th and 16th of February 2018, this report details the proceedings and outcomes.

The convening fostered connection, experience sharing, and collective problem-solving among African social movements under the theme "Agency, Power, Impact". Discussions explored the challenges and opportunities faced by these movements, highlighting the harsh political environments, the use of nonviolent resistance methods, and the importance of inter-movement solidarity.

Participants also discussed the role of women and youth, the need for sustainable funding models, and the importance of knowledge sharing and networking for future growth and impact across the continent.

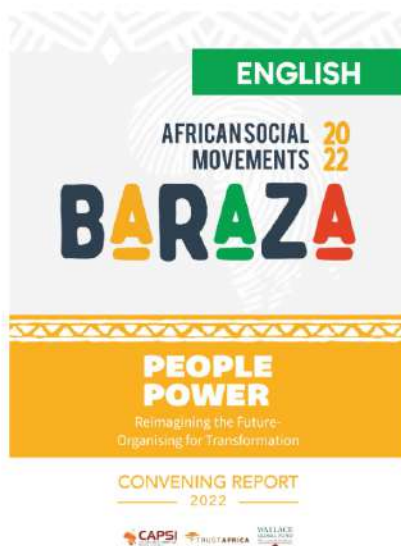
Concept note

Taking place in a post-pandemic context and facing several geopolitical shifts, the 2022 convening aimed to address challenges like the climate crisis and inequality by empowering people-centred social movements. Hosted in Johannesburg, South Africa, the convening welcomed a diverse representation of social movement actors to engage participate.

The world's failure to deal equitably with COVID-19 stands as the ultimate indictment of a global system that prioritises profit over people and ignores the needs of the most vulnerable in society. Additionally, geopolitical reconfigurations threaten to unravel all existing platforms for multilateral engagement with huge implications on issues of fundamental concern for progressives including energy, climate and just transition, economic justice as well as democracy and political rights.

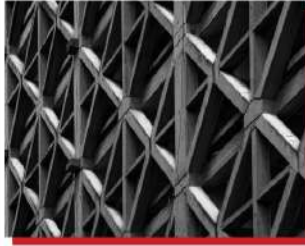

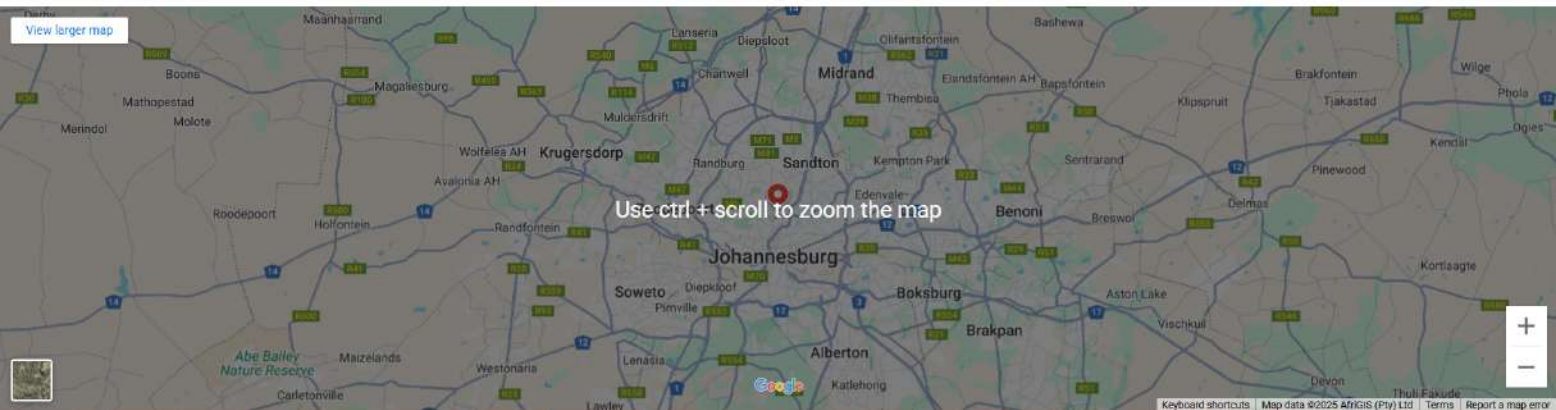

About the Convening

The Global Convening On Crisis and Care brings together critical stakeholders to build solidarity around an intersectional feminist approach to crisis response that centers collective care as a liberatory strategy and necessary anchor for crisis response.

This vibrant and diverse gathering will foreground the deep insights feminist movements bring to this work, highlight learnings from effective crisis response across regions and demonstrate how collective care supports the long-term sustainability of activists, movements, and communities amidst an onslaught of crises. In addition to the activists-only space, there is a curated dialogue for activists and donors together. The Convening is co-created with an activist advisory team and input from activist and donor participants.



Why Now?

We live in a world of complex, transnational, and intersecting crises: both acute crises such as conflict or environmental disasters and entrenched crises like closing civic space, authoritarianism, and the climate crisis. Activists and movements constantly contend with overlapping and interwoven crises that deepen existing structural harms and inequities. Feminist movements in particular have deep learnings to share about how they have long navigated and responded to crisis after crisis, always prioritizing communities not being reached by mainstream support.

Why Care?

This Global Convening centers care alongside crisis because the Urgent Action Sister Funds have learned from feminist movements that collective care is a necessity when confronting a crisis. It is particularly needed in this time of constant crisis because it supports sustainability and resilience of movements and communities over time. Further, collective care and protection are inseparable: without collective care, the protection of human rights defenders is neither sustainable nor effective. We will ground the convening in collective care practices to highlight how critical care is to effective crisis response and to support the holistic wellbeing of participants.

Global Convening Objectives

The Global Convening has five objectives that highlight solidarity, preparedness for future crises, and shifting narratives on crisis response to center collective care and focus on the key role of feminist activists, organizations, and movements.

- Deepen transnational connections**
Connect feminist activists and movements transnationally to analyze responses to crises across contexts, share and discuss what is working or not working, and strengthen cross-movement solidarity.
- Center collective care**
Illustrate how and why care is and must be the bedrock of crisis response.
- Uplift feminist crisis response strategies**
Demonstrate how feminist activists are leading community action and response to crises.
- Strengthen crisis preparedness**
Highlight trends of the most effective crisis response to inform preparedness for future crises.
- Shift philanthropic narratives on crisis response**
Make the case for centering care in crisis response and resourcing feminist and human rights movements as critical crisis responders.
